Dear Stakeholder,

You are invited to offer public comment as outlined in this notice regarding changes proposed to Chapter 4501:1-6 (Registrars and Deputy Registrars) of the Ohio Administrative Code (OAC) to implement provisions of H.B. 51 of the 130<sup>th</sup> General Assembly.

You are receiving this message pursuant to the requirements of Executive Order 2011-011K and Senate Bill 2 of the 129<sup>th</sup> General Assembly, which require state agencies, including the Ohio Department of Public Safety, Bureau of Motor Vehicles (BMV), to draft rules in collaboration with stakeholders, assess and justify any adverse impact on the business community (as defined by Senate Bill 2), and provide opportunity for interested parties to submit feedback regarding proposed rules.

OAC 4501:1-6-01, which sets forth the terms and provisions governing deputy registrar contracts, is proposed for amendment to authorize the registrar to appoint a deputy registrar to more than one deputy registrar agency; increase terms of deputy registrar contracts to five years; allow one-year contract extensions; and require individual deputy registrars to live within a one-hour commute of their respective agencies.

OAC 4501:1-6-02, which sets forth the deputy registrar selection and appointment process, is proposed for amendment to redefine eligibility to serve as a deputy registrar and limit the restriction prohibiting any deputy registrar from operating more than one agency at one time.

OAC 4501:1-6-03, which sets forth the provisions governing deputy registrar locations, is proposed for amendment to delete references to the state highway patrol in conjunction with driver license examination stations and the list referring to the various divisions of the Department of Public Safety.
