You are invited to offer public comment as outlined in this notice regarding proposed changes to Chapter 4501-52 of the Ohio Administrative Code (O.A.C.) entitled "Bus Inspections." This chapter sets forth the standards bus inspections in the State of Ohio.

You are receiving this message pursuant to the requirements of Executive Order 2011-011K and Senate Bill 2 of the 129th General Assembly, which require state agencies, including the Ohio Department of Public Safety, Ohio State Highway Patrol, to draft rules in collaboration with stakeholders, assess and justify any adverse impact on the business community (as defined by Senate Bill 2), and provide opportunity for interested parties to submit feedback regarding proposed rules.

Pursuant to its completed Revised Code (R.C.) section 119.032 five-year rule review, The Department of Public Safety, Ohio State Highway Patrol, is submitting this for your review.
