Examination alternative to continuing education.

- (A) In accordance with section 4765.31 of the Revised Code, an applicant for renewal of a certificate to practice may elect to pass an examination administered or approved by the board as an alternative to completing a continuing education requirement.
- (B) A certificate holder who elects to take an examination rather than complete a continuing education program must achieve a passing score on the examination, administered by the board in accordance with section ~~4765.29~~ 4765.10 of the Revised Code, for initial certification to practice at the level for which the certificate holder seeks renewal.
- (C) A certificate holder who elects to take an examination rather than complete a continuing education program may do so at any time during the last six months prior to the expiration of the holder's certificate to practice; or prior to the expiration of an extension issued in accordance with rule 4765-19-03 of the Administrative Code.
- (D) Such examination must be successfully completed within three attempts.
- (E) ~~If a certificate holder is unable to pass the examination prior to the certificate's expiration date, the certificate holder shall not perform any duties for which a certificate to practice is required unless the board has granted such certificate holder an extension.~~
