Inspection of aircraft.

- (A) All aircraft to be permitted shall be made available for inspection.
- (B) Except as otherwise provided in this chapter, no AMSO shall operate an aircraft without obtaining a permit from the board. In addition to submitting the appropriate fee and application to obtain a permit, an aircraft must meet or comply with the following inspections requirements:
- (1) A standardized insignia, monogram or other distinguishing characteristics of the AMSO shall be displayed on each rotorcraft air ambulance.

If an AMSO is under contract which requires other signage, the AMSO's name and service code shall be permanently affixed with each letter being at a minimum of three inches in height on both sides of the air ambulance;
 - (2) FAA airworthiness certificate shall be readily available upon request by the board;
 - (3) Contain/possess all applicable equipment set for in rule 4766-5-22 of the Administrative Code.
- (C) An AMSO shall ensure that all aircraft permits are displayed in a manner that complies with all applicable federal aviation regulations and in accordance with division (B)(3) of section 4766.07 of the Revised Code on each aircraft.
