The Ohio Department of Public Safety, Bureau of Motor Vehicles, Salvage Dealers Board ("Board"), pursuant to Chapter 119, Ohio Revised Code, will conduct a public hearing for the purpose of soliciting comments regarding the adoption, amendment and recession of rules.

The public hearing will be conducted on **Thursday, November 5, 2015** beginning at **10:00 a.m.** in room C4-9/10, located at 1970 West Broad Street, Columbus, OH 43223 and continue until all parties in attendance have had an opportunity to be heard.

The following rules are proposed for amendment to clarify and establish requirements:

- 4501:1-4-04 Place of business required for motor vehicle salvage dealers, salvage motor vehicle pools and salvage motor vehicle auctions.
- 4501:1-4-22 Nature of and length of time records will be maintained.

The following rule is proposed to be rescinded and a new rule adopted in its place:

- 4501:1-4-02 Information to accompany applications for motor vehicle salvage dealer's licenses, salvage motor vehicle pool licenses, or salvage motor vehicle auction licenses.

The following are proposed new rules:

- 4501:1-4-03 Motor vehicle salvage dealer, motor vehicle pool, or salvage motor vehicle auction required to maintain net worth.
- 4501:1-4-24 Disqualifying offenses.

The following rule is proposed to be rescinded:

- 4501:1-4-01 Definitions

Persons affected by the proposed rules may appear at the hearing and be heard in person, or by an attorney, or both, or may present their position, argument, or contention in writing. Persons may offer and examine witnesses and present evidence to show that the proposed rules will be unreasonable or unlawful if enacted.
