The Bureau of Motor Vehicles (the "BMV") and the Ohio Motor Vehicle Salvage Dealers Licensing Board will conduct a public hearing pursuant to section 119.03 of the Revised Code (R.C.) to solicit comment on the proposed adoption of 4501:1-4-01, entitled "Military provisions related to processing motor vehicle salvage dealer, salvage motor vehicle auction, and salvage motor vehicle pool applications," to the Ohio Administrative Code. This rule is proposed to implement statutory provisions set forth in House Bill 488 of the 130<sup>th</sup> General Assembly pertaining to processes that prioritize and expedite veterans' applications for occupational licensing.

Rule 4501:1-4-01 sets forth a process to prioritize and expedite applications for licensure as a motor vehicle salvage dealer, salvage motor vehicle auction, or salvage motor vehicle pool that are submitted pursuant to Chapter 4738. of the Revised Code by an applicant who is a veteran, a member of the armed forces, the spouse of a veteran or member of the armed forces, or a surviving spouse of a veteran or member of the armed forces and provides for special accommodations for applicants who face imminent deployment.

Persons affected by the proposed adoption of this rule may appear at the hearing and be heard in person, or by an attorney, or both, or may present their position, argument, or contention in writing. Persons may offer and examine witnesses and present evidence to show that the proposed rule will be unreasonable or unlawful if enacted.
