

## NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

The Ohio Motor Vehicle Dealers Licensing Board will conduct a public hearing, pursuant to section 119.03 of the Revised Code, on Thursday, December 6, 2012, at 10:00 a.m. The hearing will be held at the Ohio Department of Public Safety, Room 109, 1970 West Broad Street, Columbus, Ohio.

The purpose of the hearing is to solicit public comment on the proposal to amend rule 4501:1-4-04 (Place of business required for motor vehicle salvage dealers, salvage motor vehicle pools, and salvage motor vehicle auctions) of the Ohio Administrative Code (O.A.C.).

Rule 4501:1-4-04 is proposed for amendment to reduce the minimum square footage requirements for those motor vehicle salvage dealer facilities that deal exclusively in selling salvage parts for motorcycles, motor scooters or all purpose vehicles from fifty thousand (50,000) square feet to five thousand (5,000) square feet.

All interested parties are invited to attend the hearing. Any persons affected by the proposed rule may appear at the hearing and be heard in person, by an attorney, or both, or may present their position, argument, or contention in writing. Persons may offer and examine witnesses and present evidence to show that the proposed rule will be unreasonable or unlawful.
