Dear Stakeholder,

You are invited to offer public comment as outlined in this notice regarding the filing of Chapter 4501:1-6 of the Ohio Administrative Code (O.A.C) entitled "Registrars and Deputy Registrars" proposed pursuant to a completed five-year rule review.

You are receiving this message pursuant to the requirements of Executive Order 2011-011K and Senate Bill 2 of the 129th General Assembly, which require state agencies, including the Ohio Department of Public Safety, Bureau of Motor Vehicles (the "BMV"), to draft and review rules in collaboration with stakeholders, assess and justify any adverse impact on the business community (as defined by Senate Bill 2), and provide opportunity for interested parties to submit feedback regarding proposed rules.

Sections 4501.02, 4503.03, 4507.01, 4503.036, and other sections of the Ohio Revised Code authorize or require the Registrar of Motor Vehicles to select, appoint, and contract with certain persons to serve as Deputy Registrars and to provide driver license services, vehicle registration services, and many other services to the citizens of Ohio.

The proposed rules set forth the contract terms and conditions between the Registrar and Deputy Registrars (Rule 4501:1-6-01), the process for selecting and appointing Deputy Registrars (Rule 4501:1-6-02), the location of Deputy Registrar agencies (Rule 4501:1-6-03), the provisions for Limited Authority Deputy Registrars (Rule 4501:1-6-04), and Deputy Registrars' authority to collect reinstatement fees (Rule 4501:1-6-05).

The BMV proposes to amend Rule 4501:1-6-01 to clarify and expand the existing requirements that all Deputy Registrars maintain fiscal responsibility and financial solvency during the terms of their contracts and conform to security standards for the protection of the BMV's and their own property. Rule 4501:1-6-02 is proposed for amendment to correct a statutory reference in paragraph (B) of the rule. The BMV has determined that the remaining rules are without need of amendment at this time, and therefore, the rules are proposed without change.
