Dear Stakeholder,

You are invited to offer public comment as outlined in this notice regarding the proposed rescission of Rule 4501:1-13-03, "Motor vehicle value for an unclaimed vehicle affidavit," of the Ohio Administrative Code.

You are receiving this message pursuant to the requirements of Executive Order 2011-01K and Senate Bill 2 of the 129th General Assembly, which require state agencies, including the Ohio Department of Public Safety, Bureau of Motor Vehicles ("BMV"), to draft rules in collaboration with stakeholders, assess and justify any adverse impact on the business community (as defined by Senate Bill 2), and provide opportunity for interested parties to submit feedback regarding proposed rules.

Under prior law, the Registrar of the BMV was responsible for prescribing the standards and process by which an unclaimed vehicle's value and eligibility to file an unclaimed motor vehicle affidavit could be determined. Rule 4501:1-13-03 was adopted, pursuant to section 4505.101 of the Revised Code, to set forth those provisions. However, as of March 23, 2015, in accordance with H.B. 274 of the 130th General Assembly, eligibility requirements are now statutorily prescribed in section 4505.101 of the Revised Code, and therefore, this rule no longer serves a public purpose and is proposed for rescission.
