

Directions to Doctors Urgent Care Training Center:

From I-75 northbound: Take exit 22 (Tylersville Rd.); Turn right onto Tylersville Rd. (traveling east); Travel 5 miles and turn left onto Aero Dr.


From I-75 southbound: Take exit 22 (Tylersville Rd.); Turn left onto Tylersville Rd. (traveling east); Travel 5 miles and turn left onto Aero Dr.

From I-71 southbound: Take exit 25 (Kings Mills Rd.); Turn left onto Kings Mills Rd.; Travel 1/4 mile and turn right onto Kings Island Dr.; Travel 2 miles and turn right onto Western Row Rd. (this will turn into Tylersville Rd.); Travel 1 mile and turn right onto Aero Dr.

From I-71 northbound: Take exit 24 (Western Row Rd.); Turn left onto Western Row Rd.; Travel 1 mile and turn right onto Aero Dr.

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Acute Care Management of Chest Pain: 5 CEUs

This hands-on, scenario based class will discuss how to identify and treat patients with chest pain. It will review equipment used for treatment of chest pain, the common causes of chest pain and apply general treatment protocols to a diverse set of patient complaints that result in chest pain; cardiac and non-cardiac. We will specifically deal with Pulmonary Embolism, Pneumothorax, Myocardial Infarction, Esophageal Foreign Bodies and Congestive Heart Failure.

Acute Care Management of Respiratory Distress: 5 CEU's

During this hands-on, scenario based program, participants will learn how to triage a patient in respiratory distress, recognize common signs and symptoms of distress and determine what initial treatment interventions are most important. In debriefing scenarios participants will identify causes of respiratory distress, various diseases, and learn treatment protocols.

Rapid Patient Assessment: 6 CEUs

So much can go wrong and unnoticed with emergent patients and so many patients come through your doors. How do you tell the difference and what do you do once you notice? Do you have a system to quickly and efficiently identify, evaluate, categorize, and treat the emergent patient? This class introduces, or reacquaints, learners with the Rapid Cardiopulmonary Assessment and provides hands on scenarios for using it to treat patients with a diverse set of problems such as shock, myocardial infarction, burns, pediatric illnesses, neurologic emergencies and more.

Advanced EKG Interpretation: 6 CEUS

Reviews the fundamental components necessary to understand EKG assessment; including, heart anatomy, electrical conduction, and lead placement before delving into arrhythmias originating at all levels of the heart. Course includes MI, atrial, ventricular, re-entry, and heart block rhythms among others. This course makes a great precursor for an initial ACLS certification or a sound review.

AHA ACLS Initial Certification and Refresher

ACLS is designed for healthcare professionals who either direct or participate in the management of cardiopulmonary arrest and other cardiovascular emergencies. This includes personnel in emergency response, emergency medicine, intensive care and critical care.

EMT-Paramedic and Basic Refresher: 48 and 32 CEUs

This program meets or exceeds the Ohio Department of EMS requirements and will review up to date and relevant information on Airway/Ventilation, Cardiology, Pediatrics, Geriatrics and other topics.

Participants will demonstrate competency through both written and practical demonstrations.

EKG and Crash Cart 5 CEUs

This hands-on, scenario based program reviews the fundamental components necessary to understand EKG assessment; including, heart anatomy, electrical conduction, lead placement and initial assessment. Considering various heart conditions and associated potentially lethal dysrhythmias, the class finishes with Crash Cart/Arrest Emergency Operations and scenarios
