**Criteria for a certificate to teach fire service training.**

(A) The executive director shall issue a certificate to teach a firefighter or fire safety inspector training program to an individual who meets all of the following:

- (1) Submits a completed application on a form approved by the executive director;
- (2) Is in compliance with all entrance requirements outlined in this chapter;
- (3) Has successfully completed a fire instructor training program as set forth in rule 4765-11-15 of the Administrative Code;
- (4) Has passed, within three attempts, the techniques examination as set forth in rule 4765-20-06 of the Administrative Code;

Failure to pass the techniques examination within three attempts will require completion of a new fire service instructor training program. Credit for the written fire instructor knowledge examination shall remain valid for two years from the date of successful completion of this examination.

- (5) Has completed all requirements for a certificate to teach within two years of successful completion of the written knowledge examination.
- (6) Is in compliance with the requirements set forth in paragraphs (A)(2) to (A)(6) of rule 4765-20-02 of the Administrative Code.

(B) A certified instructor shall maintain a current and valid certificate of fire service training.

(C) A certificate to teach shall run concurrently with the individual's certificate of fire training and may be renewed by the executive director pursuant to rule 4765-21-04 of the Administrative Code.
