



# State Board of Emergency Medical Services Rules Committee Meeting Report August 18, 2010 Board Meeting

**The Rules Committee met on Wednesday, July 21, 2010. The following items were discussed:**

## ***SB 58 Draft Rules***

Preliminary draft of rules regarding blood draw for evidence collection were presented and discussed. Concepts were approved, with the direction to work with legal to finalize language and formatting. Draft rules to be mailed with the board packet.

## ***Instructor Rules***

The following instructor rules were discussed. Concepts approved as drafted. Legal review still needs to be conducted before being sent to the board. Additionally rule 4765-18-09 was sent to in-house counsel at the Medical Board to ensure the rule did not contradict the laws and rules of the Medical Board.

- 4765-18-09**      Qualifications for a physician as instructor or an individual holding a certificate of training as a physician  
*Added language that allows for an individual holding certificate training as a MD or DO to be granted a certificate to teach Continuing education*
- 4765-18-15**      Qualifications for a certificate to teach continuing education  
*No change needed*
- 4765-18-21**      Upgrade process for certificate to teach as an assistant EMS instructor to EMS instructor  
*Added language to clarify an individual must pass the knowledge examination in the preceding three years in order to become an EMS instructor. Additionally, clarified if the individual passed the knowledge examination in order to become certified as an Assistant Instructor, the test is not required again.*
- 4765-18-03**      EMS instructor training program requirements for an accredited institution  
*Pre-maturely sent to Rules, per last Education Committee Meeting the rule was tabled at the last Education Committee meeting. Rules Committee sent back to Education.*

## ***Five Year Rule Review – 2-13-2011***

The committee began looking at the rules that are up for five year review, due February 13, 2011. The reinstatement versus reciprocity practice was in question and had been referred to the Rules Committee for discussion. Chair Bill Mallory has asked the Board members to comment on the process before the August Board meeting. Rules up for review are as follows:
