For the second year, the Ohio Investigative Unit (OIU) will be holding a Cops and Kids Day in Cleveland. The positive feedback and interaction last year with students, school officials, parents and neighbors prompted OIU, a division of the Ohio Department of Public Safety, and Luis Muñoz Marín Principal Jamie Lindsey to hold another Cops and Kids event.

Cops and Kids offers students a chance to talk to law enforcement officers and first responders and see what type of equipment is used each day to save lives and make their communities safe.
