### FIFTEEN ADMINISTRATIVE CHARGES FILED AGAINST CLEVELAND ADULT BUSINESS

**(Columbus)** – Undercover agents with the Ohio Investigative Unit (OIU) and members of the Cleveland Police Department executed a search warrant Wednesday after receiving complaints about drug abuse at Gold Restaurant, Inc., also known as Crazy Horse.

OIU filed 15 administrative charges against Gold Restaurant, Inc., located at 1438 St. Clair Avenue in Cleveland. Those administrative charges include: one count each of disorderly activity, solicitation of something of value and drug possession; and four counts each of nudity, engaging in sexual activity and public indecency.

“We have a responsibility to make sure that all liquor permit premises are following the law,” said Cleveland Agent-in-Charge Greg Croft. “During this operation, undercover agents were subjected to sexual activity that was beyond the legal limits of the adult entertainment industry.”

Pending criminal charges will be presented to the Cleveland municipal prosecutor. Administrative charges will be forwarded to the Liquor Control Commission. Possible penalties may include a fine, suspension or revocation.
