## Ohio BMV Registrar Mike Rankin Appointed to AAMVA Board of Directors

**COLUMBUS** – Ohio Bureau of Motor Vehicles (BMV) Registrar Mike Rankin was recently appointed to the American Association of Motor Vehicle Administrators (AAMVA) Board of Directors.

The Board consists of 12 voting members, elected by the 50 U.S. state member jurisdictions. Elected members serve terms of three years, not serving more than two consecutive terms.

“It’s an honor to be selected to serve on AAMVA’s Board of Directors,” said BMV Registrar Mike Rankin. “Through the combined efforts of our 50 states, territories and Canadian Provinces, we will confront important issues that face the motor vehicle community.”

Mike Rankin has served as the leader and Registrar of the Ohio Bureau of Motor Vehicles since January 2011. He held this position previously for more than two years 2007-2009. Rankin previously served on the AAMVA Board from 2008-2009. Prior to returning to the BMV, he served as the Assistant Secretary of State.

Rankin has 31 years of experience as a practicing attorney. Rankin is a member of the Columbus Rotary, co-founder of Ohio's first formal child protection group, the Mid-Ohio Amber Alert, and has served on the Governor's State Amber Alert Board and Steering Committee since 2003.

Rankin is a graduate of The Ohio State University and the University of Toledo School of Law.
