REGISTRATION RENEWALS FOR APPORTIONED COMMERCIAL VEHICLES NOW AVAILABLE ONLINE

COLUMBUS- Beginning Monday, June 25, 2012, the Ohio Bureau of Motor Vehicles will allow commercial truck drivers to use a new online system for yearly registration renewals.

The Web site will offer renewal services for the International Registration Plan (IRP), a registration reciprocity agreement between all states, the District of Columbia and the provinces of Canada. The agreement provides payment of apportioned fees on the basis of total distance operated in each jurisdiction.

Ohio Apportioned Registration is for vehicles that are:

- Power units with a gross weight in excess of 26,000 pounds, or;
- Power units with three or more axels regardless of weight, or;
- Power units used in combination with another unit together exceeding 26,000 pounds

During 2011, Ohio collected nearly \$120 million in registration fees from Ohio based companies, as well as out-of-state truckers who drive through on Ohio roads.

The new online system will not only significantly reduce the registration processing time, but will benefit out-of-state drivers who may be unable to return to Ohio to process registration paperwork.
