OIU ARRESTS 32 AT 'ALL GOOD FESTIVAL'

One organization also charged

(Columbus) – The Ohio Investigative Unit charged 32 people with alcohol and drug citations during the weekend “All Good Festival” at Legend Valley in Licking County.

One organization was cited for the same administrative violations on two different dates. Lakewood Athletic Boosters was charged with illegal possession of alcoholic beverages, and allowing consumption of alcohol not purchased at the premises. The administrative charges against the organization will be presented to the Ohio Liquor Commission.

“Our agents worked hard to help keep the music festival a fun, safe event,” Columbus Agent-in-Charge SuAnn Cook said. “The crimes of a few partiers can endanger the thousands of others who respect the law, have fun and behave responsibly. Everybody deserves a safe event.”

The 32 people who received criminal citations face 56 charges, including:

- 22 for drug possession
- 15 for underage drinking or possessing alcohol
- 6 for drug trafficking
- 2 for furnishing alcohol to an underage person
- 3 for drug paraphernalia
- 2 for illegal sales
- 2 for fake IDs
- 2 for resisting arrest
- 1 for attempted purchase of alcohol by an underage person
- 1 for assaulting an officer

OIU agents seized a large quantity of black tar heroin during one arrest and 90 hits of LSD during a separate arrest. Agents also confiscated drug paraphernalia, moonshine, prescription pills, MDMA and marijuana, among other illegal substances.
