OIU, Springfield Police Conduct Compliance Checks

Three people charged, three businesses cited

Agents with the Ohio Investigative Unit and officers with the Springfield Police Department conducted compliance checks on Oct. 4. Of the seven locations checked, three sold alcohol to a minor. LIMCA Inc., also known as BP Food Mart 593, 2598 East Main St; CDC Holdings LTD., also known as Main Street Pub., 204 East Main St.; and Infusions Fine Dining & Spirits, 42 Fountain St. were administratively cited for sale and/or furnishing beer to a person under 21.

Jon D. Bussard, 24, and Blair Salyers, 24, both of Springfield, and Cassandra C. Workman, 21, of Medway, were charged with sale of alcohol to an underage person. These charges will be presented to the Clark County Municipal Court for their consideration.

Administrative charges will be filed with the Liquor Control Commission once all criminal proceedings have been completed. Possible administrative penalties could include fines, suspension or revocation of the liquor permit.

OIU conducts compliance checks to see if liquor permit holders are following Ohio's liquor laws. Often the agents work compliance checks jointly with local law enforcement.
