Public Complaints Lead OIU Agents to Cite Cleveland Adult Entertainment Club with Nudity and Soliciting

(Columbus) – After receiving public complaints against an adult entertainment club in Cleveland, undercover Ohio Investigative Unit agents observed improper conduct with regards to nudity in a liquor permit establishment and solicitation of drinks.

On December 7, agents cited Al Sol, Inc., also known as Fox Haven Show Bar, 4623 Clark Ave., with nudity and retail permit holder soliciting something of value.

The administrative charges will then be presented to the Ohio Liquor Control Commission for their consideration. The commission has the authority to issue penalties against the liquor permit including possible fines, suspensions or revocation.
