BMV OPLATES REACHES TEN MILLION REGISTRATION TRANSACTIONS

COLUMBUS – The Bureau of Motor Vehicles' Ohio Public Licensing Access through Electronic Services (OPLATES) Website has reached ten million registration transactions.

OPLATES was developed to offer Ohioans the ability to perform registration transactions via internet and telephone. Since the first online registration transaction on September 20, 2000, OPLATES.com has grown in productivity and enhancements.

In the past ten years, Ohioans have seen many new options offered via OPLATES including a Live Help feature, Address Change, Fleet renewals, and a search function for Frequently Asked Questions. Currently customers can process over seven registration types in both English and Spanish, including registration status updates, plate exchanges and/or replacements and check the availability of special plates. The most highly used feature is online vehicle renewal.
