Auto Title North Moves to New Facility at 980 Morse Road

Auto Title North is scheduled to relocate its offices from the Patio Shops to 980 Morse Road, and will open for business at 8 a.m. on November 10. The newly remodeled branch is within 1/3 mile of the 71 S/N interstate, and has easy access off Morse Road. Auto Title North's move is within one month of the Franklin County Clerk of Courts' West-side title branch's relocation to its new facility in the Hollywood Plaza.

"I'm delighted that we were able to maintain our North-side title operation in the immediate area," said Clerk of Courts Maryellen O'Shaughnessy. "We can provide our exceptional level of service to not only the general public but all auto dealers along the Morse Road corridor who have been our loyal, regular customers."

Auto Title North continues with hours of operation Mondays through Fridays, 8 a.m. to 5 p.m. and Saturdays 8 a.m. to noon. The newly renovated space features check-in kiosks for both the general public and business customers. An on-site Business Center is an enhanced feature for dealerships and financial businesses, and will provide customized transactional services. A seated waiting area for the general public, and ample parking are among other notable upgrades at the new site.

"This final move of Auto Title North satisfies our strategic plan's objectives to upgrade and expand Auto Title office space, brand the "Next Generation" of Franklin County Auto Title branches, and offer customers an enhanced level of all our title services," said Kenny Skeaton, Auto Title Division Director.

A State of Ohio Bureau of Motor Vehicles Deputy Registrar is located in the same shopping area. The proximity of the state office and county auto title branch provide auto title and BMV business customers a one-stop option.

Auto Title North and the three other Auto Title branches will close on 11/11 in observation of the Veteran's Day holiday, and will reopen on 11/12.
