### OIU and Beavercreek Police check 19 liquor permits, four cited

Agents with the Ohio Department of Public Safety's Ohio Investigative Unit and officers with the Beavercreek Police Department conducted alcohol compliance checks on Saturday. Of the 19 liquor permits checked, only four sold to an underage informant.

Agents administratively cited Wildenhaus Restaurants, Inc., also known as Tutty's, 3982 Colonel Glenn Highway; Pub Dayton, LLC., also known as The Pub, 39 Greene Blvd.; Ruchfam Enterprises, Inc., also known as BP, 4362 Indian Ripple; and QSLPA Investments of Ohio Limited, also known as Quaker Steak & Lube, 3752 Presidential Drive for sale/furnishing beer to a person under 21.

Beavercreek Police charged four people for selling beer to a person under 21.

The individuals charged will appear in the Fairborn Municipal Court. Administrative charges against the liquor permit will be presented to the Ohio Liquor Control Commission for their consideration. Possible administrative penalties from the commission could include fines, suspension or revocation of the liquor permit.

OIU conducts compliance checks to determine if liquor permit holders are compliant in regards to Ohio's liquor laws. The agents regularly work compliance checks jointly with local law enforcement.

*The Ohio Investigative Unit agents are plain-clothed fully sworn peace officers. OIU is charged with enforcing the state's liquor laws and is the only state law enforcement agency specifically tasked with investigating food stamp fraud crimes. Agents also investigate tobacco violations.*
