The Ohio Department of Public Safety (ODPS) has received numerous inquiries regarding the date on which dealers are to begin transmitting daily transaction reports.

In accordance with R.C. 4737.04(E)(1)(b) and 4737.045(E)(3), dealers are required to prepare and submit a daily electronic reports in accordance with the administrative rules adopted by the Director of ODPS. Development and adoption of these rules is ongoing and being done in conjunction with stakeholders as required. ODPS anticipates that these rules will not become effective until on or around July 1, 2014.

ODPS will provide you with notice well in advance, of any required submissions. Additionally, you may access the latest news at Ohio Homeland Security's website at <http://www.homelandsecurity.ohio.gov> regarding these rules, as well as opportunities to participate in the rule-making process.
