- Interpretation of the L.E.A.D.S. Printouts.  
Cancellation of fraudulent OL/ID's, Fraud Alerts appearing on L.E.A.D.S.
- In-transit plates, Special plates, Dealer plates.
- Applicable Criminal Charges for Law Enforcement.

The class contains sensitive material which is restricted to Law Enforcement Officials, Courts, License Agencies, and Title Offices. The class will receive "hands on" instruction to identify specific features on different documents.
