BMV DEPUTY REGISTRAR AGENCY

Customers may visit any [Deputy Registrar agency](#) for all reinstatement needs:

- Acceptance and posting of reinstatement payments;
- Processing of reinstatement paperwork; and
- The BMV's Reinstatement Processing staff will validate a customer's driving status and will request additional information (if applicable). If reinstatement is approved, the Deputy Registrar can immediately issue a driver license or a temporary instruction permit identification card (TIPIIC) if re-testing is required.

HOW TO GET STARTED

Customers can review and print reinstatement requirements online at BMV Online Services, www.bmv.ohio.gov, or a Reinstatement Requirement Letter (BMV2006) serves as a checklist to collect all needed documentation **before** going to a [Deputy Registrar agency](#).

Customers can call the BMV's toll-free number at 1-844-OHIOBMV (644-6268) where agents will walk customers through the reinstatement requirements and/or any needed documents to take to the agency for processing.
