REVIEW AND APPROVAL OF CONSENT AGENDA

Ms. Harris requested a motion to approve the consent agenda including the June 17, 2015 Firefighter and Fire Safety Inspector Training Committee meeting minutes, the certifications, accreditations, and CE site requests for period June 16, 2015 through August 18, 2015.

ACTION: Motion to approve the Consent Agenda items including the June 17, 2015 meeting minutes, the certifications, accreditations, and CE site requests for period June 16, 2015 through August 18, 2015. Mr. McNutt– First. Mr. Wright – Second. None – Abstained. None opposed. Motion approved.

REPORT AND RECOMMENDATION IN THE MATTER OF FIRE CASE(S)

Ms. Harris began the deliberation and noted that Executive Director Melvin House was also present. The Committee will be deliberating on two *Report and Recommendations* (R & R) in the matter of:

- In the matter of Fire Case Number 2014-312-BF100, William A. Eberly, Fire Certificate Number 136954
- In the matter of Fire Case Number 2014-457-F500, Patrick A. Bryant, Fire Certificate Number 166470

Mr. Eberly filed objections to the Report and Recommendation, which have been provided to the members in the board packet. Ms. Harris recognized Assistant Attorney General Rico Barrera for the purpose of providing a brief synopsis of the case and a recommendation for disciplinary action.

AAG Barrera presented Fire Case Number 2014-312-BF100, William A. Eberly, Fire Certificate Number 136954. Mr. Eberly went before the EMFTS Board earlier today. The hearing examiner concluded that by preponderance of the evidence that Mr. Eberly was convicted of three counts of unlawful sexual conduct with a minor which are crimes involving moral turpitude. Mr. Eberly failed to disclose these convictions on his 2011 initial application and his 2013 renewal application. In failing to disclose these convictions Mr. Eberly committed fraud, misrepresentation or deception. Accordingly the hearing examiner recommended a penalty of revocation.

Ms. Harris asked Mr. Eberly if he wished to address the board. Mr. Eberly stated that he had evidence that the girl lied about her age. The village he serves knew the circumstances and felt he was more than capable to be fire chief.

AAG presented EMS Case Number 2014-457-F500, Patrick A. Bryant, Fire Certificate Number 166470. At the hearing the examiner found that after Mr. Bryant received his certification that he cheated on the State certifying exam. Mr. Bryant was forthright and admitted to cheating. He was suspended immediately from his department and has not worked as a firefighter since. The hearing examiner concluded it was a violation of Sections 4765-20-02(A)(6) and 4765-22-01(E) of the OAC. Accordingly the hearing examiner recommended a penalty of revocation.

Ms. Harris requested a motion to recess the meeting for the purpose of entering into quasi-judicial deliberations on the matter pursuant to Ohio Revised Code Chapter 119 and that are required to be kept confidential under R.C. 4765.102(B). The Committee will reconvene following deliberations.

ACTION: Motion to adjourn to Executive Session for the purpose of entering into quasi-judicial deliberations on these matters pursuant to Ohio Revised Code Chapter 119 and that are required to be kept confidential under R.C. 4765.102(B). FIRE CERTIFICATIONS & EXEMPTION REQUESTS (Military & Medical), Jean Booze

Certification, Jean Booze

Jean Booze reported on the CE exemptions. There were a total of two CE exemption requests due to military exemption requests: #2015-8-01; dual certified, who is still on active duty and the staff recommends approval. The Fire only #2015-8-02 is being requested by a certificate holder who completed 5 years of active military service where he received the Bronze Star and Purple Heart. This is his second consecutive exemption request. His first request was approved for his last certification cycle which ended on October 18, 2012. He is still in the reserves and he was released from active duty March 2014. His certification does not expire until October 18, 2015.

A discussion ensued as to why in 18 months the certificate holder was unable to complete continuing education requirements. Ms. Booze stated she does not have any documentation; however, he stated that he received rehabilitation after his discharge. It is unknown as to the type of rehabilitation. He is not currently working in the fire service. After a lengthy discussion a motion was made to approve the exemption requests.

ACTION: Motion to approve exemption requests for #2015-8-01 and #2015-8-02.

COMMITTEE REPORT

Firefighter Committee Report, Doug Orahod

The EMS and Course Administration System has been deployed with the final changes. This is not just a testing system, but also a course management system.

The Live Fire Training Course has been completed. The subcommittee has recommended to change the rules to make it part of certifications.

Our future goals include review of the volunteer firefighter course and fire safety inspector course. Also being reviewed is the reporting and statistical analysis of the examinations.

Mr. Davis asked if there is a way to ensure that the current charter fire programs have policies regarding weather extremes.

Action Item: Executive Director House to review the charter's policies to determine if they have something in place regarding extreme weather and determine if it should be a requirement.

These proceedings shall be an affidavit-based adjudication relative to a Notice of Opportunity for Hearing mailed to the respondents in the aforementioned cases and believed to have been properly served according to the Administrative Procedures Act (Chapter 119, of the Ohio Revised Code).

As the respondents did not properly request a hearing in the case, the proceeding was held before the Board pursuant to *Goldman v. State Medical Board of Ohio*. The individuals named do not have the ability to present written or oral testimony, but may be present to hear the proceeding and outcome.

All Board members received the sworn affidavits from the EMS investigators and accompanying exhibits for the Goldman proceeding in the board packet. The affidavits contained the evidence and testimony upon which was deliberated. Although all had the opportunity to review the affidavit and accompanying exhibits, additional time was allowed to review if needed. No additional time was required.

In lieu of a stenographic record being made, the minutes reflect that the original sworn affidavits and exhibits will be kept as the official record of the proceeding in the aforementioned matter in the Office of the Division of EMS.

Ms. Harris recognized Assistant Attorney General Rico Barrera for the purpose of providing a brief synopsis of each case and a recommendation for disciplinary action.

- William R. Ray applied for reinstatement and did not provide proof of continuing education. The recommendation is to deny the reinstatement.
- William Nowagarski applied to renew his Firefighter II and Firefighter Inspector certificate. EMS received a complaint that he had not completed the continuing education requirements. The recommendation is to revoke both certificates.
- Charles A. Altman applied for renewal and marked no for continuing education. He failed to complete all continuing education requirements. The recommendation is to revoke his certification.
- Damien J. Csiszar was convicted of a fifth-degree felony of Aggravated Theft and he failed to report the conviction. He failed to provide appropriate records. The recommendation is to revoke his certification.
- Sharleen E. Hemminger matter to be tabled until the next Board meeting.
- Scott K. Riffle was convicted of a fifth-degree felony for Workers' Compensation Fraud. He worked full time as an EMT while receiving Workers' Compensation. He failed to report the conviction or provide appropriate records. The recommendation is to revoke his certification.
- Joshua L. Hopper, Arthur Milhoan and William E. Williams were audited and did not respond. Recommendation is to revoke all three certifications.
- Victor E. Coutcher applied for reinstatement; however, he was convicted of Indecent Exposure, a misdemeanor. The recommendation is to deny his reinstatement application.
- Tyler S. Lyons and Kristian B. Avery were both selected for random continuing education audits and did not provide proof. The recommendation is to revoke their certifications.
- Michael A. Thian provided some proof of continuing education; however, more time is being provided to confirm. The recommendation is to table the matter until next Board meeting.
- Chris D. Noble supplied the required continuing education hours; therefore the recommendation is to close Mr. Noble's case

Having heard AAG Duck's synopses and recommended disciplinary actions for the cases, Ms. Harris requested a motion to admit the sworn affidavit and the accompanying exhibits in the aforementioned cases into evidence.

Altman, Fire Certificate Number 156644, the Committee finds that Mr. Altman failed to complete all continuing education requirements after attesting to the fact that he had satisfied the requirements; therefore not meeting the renewal requirements. Accordingly, Mr. Altman violated Ohio Administrative Code 4765-23-02(A)(2) and 4765-20-07(A)(3); therefore the committee recommends to the Executive Director to revoke Mr. Altman's firefighter certificate. Mr. Davis – First. Mr. McNutt – Second. None opposed. None abstained. Motion approved.

ACTION: In the matter of Fire Case Number 2014-366-BF100, Damien J. Csiszar, Fire Certificate Number 112285, the Committee finds that Mr. Csiszar failed to report his conviction and failed to supply court records, police records, and a background check, as required.
