TOPIC	Medical Director's Report			
	<p>Dr. Cunningham reported on meeting she had with Dr. Ashkenazi who had developed a simulation lab in Ohio that addressed terrorist attacks. Dr. Ashkenazi also presented a mass casualty care symposium attended by Dr. Cunningham, Mel House and Mark Resanovich. The symposium included Tactical Emergency Casualty Care and a patient care protocol for active shooter incidents including pediatrics. Dr. Cunningham proposed that we develop a "version 2" of an active shooter incident protocol for Ohio and include it in crisis planning.</p> <p>They also have a Mobile Medical Unit in Bedford, Ohio which can be easily and readily deployed.</p> <p>Mark Resanovich said there were two take-away points to remember:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. The doctrine in Israel concerning mass care of casualties includes citizen involvement – a responsibility to act as a civilian. This is much different than what we experience in the U.S. 2. Dr. Kelly Victory – her system incorporates EMS with Law Enforcement in her position paper. <p>Guest Robert Schlicher stated that CIMS has a number of videos available that deal with these types of scenarios.</p>
