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## Acute Care Management of Chest Pain: 5 CEU's

This class will discuss how to identify and treat patients with chest pain. It will review equipment used for treatment of chest pain, the common causes of chest pain and apply general treatment protocols to common chest pain case scenario's.

## Basic EKG Assessment and Crash Cart: 5 CEU's

This program reviews the fundamental components necessary to understand EKG assessment; including, heart anatomy, electrical conduction, lead placement and initial assessment. Considering various heart conditions and associated dysrhythmias, the class finishes with Crash Cart/Arrest Emergency Operations and scenarios

## Basic Pediatric Assessment: 5 CEU's

This class is designed to increase your skills in working with pediatric patients. Participants will learn how to obtain and understand basic interpretation of vital signs, including initial patient assessment. This program will also review techniques to help implement clinical procedures, pain management strategies and helping children cope with stressful experiences.

## Acute Care Management of Respiratory Distress: 5 CEU's

During this program, participants will learn how to triage a patient in respiratory distress, recognize common signs and symptoms of distress and determine what initial treatment interventions are most important. During the second portion of class, participants will identify causes of respiratory distress, various diseases, and learn treatment protocols.

## Pharmacology of Injectable Medications & Vaccines: 5 CEU's

This program will review the responsibilities associated with administering injections as well as methods and locations of administration. Medications commonly used in the Urgent Care setting will be identified along with their dosing, indications, adverse reactions and other pertinent information related to the drug.

## EMT-Basic Refresher 30 CEUs

This program meets or exceeds the Ohio Department of EMS requirements and will review up to date and relevant information on Airway/Ventilation, Cardiology, Pediatrics, Geriatrics and other topics.

Participants will demonstrate competency through both written and practical demonstrations.

## EMT-Paramedic Refresher: 48 CEUs

This program meets or exceeds the Ohio Department of EMS requirements and will review up to date and relevant information on Airway/Ventilation, Cardiology, Pediatrics, Geriatrics and other topics.

Participants will demonstrate competency through both written and practical demonstrations.


### Directions to Doctors Urgent Care Training Center:

From I-71 southbound: Take exit 25 (Kings Mills Rd.); Turn left onto Kings Mills Rd.; Travel 1/4 mile and turn right onto Kings Island Dr.; Travel 2 miles and turn right onto Western Row Rd. (this will turn into Tylersville Rd.); Travel 1 mile and turn right onto Aero Dr.

From I-71 northbound: Take exit 24 (Western Row Rd.); Turn left onto Western Row Rd.; Travel 1 mile and turn right onto Aero Dr.
