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DISCUSSION	<p>Critical Care Committee Welcomed: Chris and Ann from Eagle County Colorado Tonya Morris and Paul from West Virginia</p> <p>Discussion: License Qualification Guests introduced themselves – Julie introduced the subcommittee for Ohio Julie started off with asking the guests if they can share the benefit of establishing that level of care: Chris: With joint effort we formulated statewide critical care program that everyone takes the same class (paramedic, RN, air medic or ground CCT (Critical Care Transport). Legislatively designates CCT as a separate class. That has been helpful. Scope of Practice; List of procedures that paramedics can do Basically, if it's in this list; you can do it. Either Paramedic or Mobile Care RN Ann (CO) – Has information to share on position statements (PowerPoint). State College; state curriculum Evidence; data to use should the state pass a law if it benefits the patient. Question was asked, Does the organization take on the cost? Colorado & W.
