



OHIO CONTINUING EDUCATION REQUIREMENTS

EMT-Paramedic - 4765-17-02

- Minimum of 86 CE hours within three year certification cycle;
 - Must include at least 12 hrs pediatrics, 4 hrs geriatric, 6 hrs of emergency cardiac care (which may be satisfied by an ACLS course of the AHA, ASHI or equivalent program approved by the EMS Board) and 8 hours of trauma issues to include triage and transportation protocols approved by the board

OR

- Completion of an EMT-P refresher course which will satisfy 48 of the required 86 hours of continuing education plus 38 hours of additional CE;

OR

- Current registration with the National Registry of EMT at the EMT-P or equivalent level and completion of trauma triage and transportation protocols approved by the board;

OR

- Passing score within three attempts on an exam approved by the board. This exam may only be taken during the last six months of an EMT-Paramedic's current certification period.
