- Active shooter incidents have been on the increase in our society. It was suggested that education and training be provided for free to EMS providers for these type of situations. These are not certification courses. Active shooter education is being developed so EMS can integrate at the local level (this is not TEMS) with law enforcement. The board approved the Homeland Security Subcommittee in conjunction with the Education Committee to include the appropriate stakeholders to develop education and training for EMS providers in the event of an active shooter incidence.
