TOPIC	Active Shooter Training			
DISCUSSION	<p>Development of active shooter courses were discussed. Ms. Beavers explained the EMFTS Board's motion requesting the Homeland Security Subcommittee in conjunction with the Education Committee to develop training for EMS providers that may be called to the scene of an active shooter incident.</p> <p>The active shooter training will be developed with input from appropriate stakeholders to ensure that, should the situation arise, EMS providers will be able to integrate with local law enforcement. Ms. Beavers stated that the active shooter training would not be part of a certificate course.</p> <p>In addition, the training would be a rescue task force level of training for a "warm zone" situation, not tactical EMS training, which is more focused on a "hot zone" situation. It was suggested that education and training be provided for free to EMS providers.</p>

TOPIC	Rule Review
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DISCUSSION	<p>The EMFTS Board requested the Education Committee review proposed amendments to OAC rule 4765-8-01 and chapter 4765-9. The proposed amendments to OAC rule 4765-8-01 require an individual seeking an EMT initial certification to complete an emergency vehicle operation course (EVOC) prior to submitting an initial EMT application. The EVOC would not be part of an initial certification course. The committee would like to review all changes in OAC chapter 4765-8 prior to making a recommendation to the EMFTS Board.</p> <p>Ms. Beavers explained that proposed changes to OAC chapter 4765-9 will clarify the rule requirements. Motion was made by David Yarmesch to recommend the proposed changes to OAC chapter 4765-9. Kristopher Alexander seconded the motion, motion passed.</p>
