



Become an Assistant Fire Instructor?

To be an eligible candidate for Assistant Fire Instructor certification, you must be a firefighter currently certified by the State of Ohio and have 5 years out of the preceding 7 years of experience as a certified firefighter. For admission to the course, you must pass a knowledge exam at your level of certification. You will have to successfully complete a course on NFPA standard 1403 through one of Ohio's chartered fire training programs, which are located at multiple locations throughout the state.
