DOCUMENT NUMBER

Definition: Identifies the document number assigned by Public Safety to individual crashes. The format is (YYYYPNNNNNN). YYYY = Crash Year; P = Vendor Prefix Number, NNNNNN = Numbered Crash (values will be 000001 through 999999).

DATE (DATE OF CRASH)

Definition: Identifies the date of the crash. The format will be MM/DD/YYYY.

HOUR (TIME OF CRASH)

Definition: Identifies the military time of crash (HH24:MI).

UNITS:

Definition: Total number of motorist/non-motorist involved.

DEATHS: (TOTAL KILLED)

Definition: Identifies the total number of persons killed within 30 days of the crash. Injuries, which become delayed deaths after 30 days are not included as fatal injuries.

INJURD: (TOTAL INJURED)

Definition: Identifies the total number of person injured in the crash.

VEHERR: (VEHICLE IN ERROR)

Definition: Identifies the vehicle number in error.

NOTE: IF THE ERROR WAS UNDETERMINED, THE ERROR CODE WILL BE '99'.
IF AN ANIMAL CAUSED THE CRASH, THE ERROR CODE WILL BE '98'.

FHE: (FIRST HARMFUL EVENT)

Definition: The sequence of events that produced the first property damage, injury, or death.
