## Alcohol in Other Countries

Countries vary in their definitions of what constitutes an alcohol-involved traffic crash. In some countries, a crash is defined as alcohol-involved if any alcohol is detected in the driver (for example, Belgium, Canada, the Netherlands, Spain and the United States). Other countries extend this definition to include alcohol detected in pedestrians that were involved in the crash (for example, Belgium, Canada, Spain and the United States). And yet other countries define a crash as alcohol-involved if a driver has a blood alcohol concentration (BAC) over the legal limit for that country (such as Australia, Austria, Denmark, Finland, France, New Zealand, Norway, Spain, United Kingdom and the United States). New Zealand and Sweden define alcohol involvement based on police reports that alcohol was involved.

Most countries consider a death that occurs within 30 days following a crash as being caused by the crash. France has a time limit of eight days, and Canada's limit is 12 months. Some countries do not have a specific time limit (for example, Belgium, Denmark and Finland). (source: NHTSA)




## POP Culture Campaign
