

PROJECT DESCRIPTION


The Cops In Shops program was designed for retail establishments, law enforcement and the media to work together to stop underage alcohol purchases. Undercover officers, posing as employees, were randomly placed in participating stores to deter underage alcohol purchases. Officers were also outside the store to prevent individuals from purchasing alcohol for minors.


