



## SALUTE TO NEW ALBANY PD

In 2002 the New Albany Police Department purchased Fatal Vision Goggles that duplicate impairment caused by a specific level of alcohol or other drug ingested by a person. These goggles are an educational tool for students and citizens. Since purchasing the goggles, officers have taken them into the high school and to health and wellness fairs sponsored by local corporations. The students and citizens who put on the goggles are then asked to perform the heel to toe portion of the field sobriety test. The New Albany PD has even used golf carts driven through obstacle courses to demonstrate the effects alcohol and drugs have on the driver's brain and body. The feedback has been very positive.

## Letter to Law Enforcement

Recently, a letter from the Ohio Department of Public Safety Director Kenneth L. Morckel and Executive Director Vernon Chenevey of the Ohio Peace Officer Training Academy was sent to all law enforcement administrators.

The letter informed them that on July 1, 2003, the blood alcohol concentration (BAC) for per se levels of alcohol impairment for drivers in Ohio will change to .08 (.11 for urine) as required by Ohio House Bill 87. The .08 BAC standard will not require any significant changes in training or operational standards.

However, law enforcement administrators are encouraged to review the changes with their officers and staff and ensure each officer begins utilizing this critical law enforcement tool beginning July 1, 2003.

Later this year, new traffic law books along with a law enforcement officer quick-reference summary incorporating the .08 standard and other Ohio Revised Code changes associated with Senate Bill 123 (effective January 1, 2004) will be distributed throughout Ohio.

As with any changes, specific local procedural issues should be discussed with your prosecutor and applicable court.
