



Lt. Donald Boggs arrested Steven Petrick, 36, for his **ELEVENTH DUI** offense on 06/13/03. He tested .227 BAC. He was also charged with driving under suspension and child endangering.

Letter from a Judge

Recently, the Hot Sheet News staff received a letter from a judge that was very complimentary to the Habitual Offender's program. The judge wrote, "Please accept and extend my sincere appreciation to your department for this publication which has been instrumental in apprehending DUI offenders that pose a risk to the community. Once again, I am grateful for the assistance, cooperation and dedication of those police agencies that have been essential in this venture."

This court checks the habitual offenders, computer system first to see if the cases are filed in their court and second for the current status. If it is found that the defendant has failed to appear, and there is an active warrant for his/her arrest, then they contact an officer who is assigned to the Fugitive Task Force and supply him or her with the information they have available. This procedure has worked for the arrest and conviction of two people listed in the March 2003 Hot Sheet News.






