

Sobriety Checkpoints in Two Counties Net 19 Impaired Drivers

Two sobriety checkpoints were held recently that netted a total of 19 impaired drivers. One was in Franklin County and the other was in Fairfield County. The Franklin County DUI Task Force held a sobriety checkpoint on July 9, 2004. There were 1,339 vehicles passing through the checkpoint held on Frank Road East of US Route 62. There were a total of 11 DUI arrests made. Other results included:

- 580 vehicles checked
- 52 seconds was the average time per vehicle
- 62 vehicles were diverted
- 22 DUS arrests made
- 21 were cited for no operators licenses
- 16 vehicles were seized
- 3 warrants were issued
- .128 was the average BAC
- 5 people refused the BAC test

Members of the Franklin County DUI Task Force include the Franklin County Sheriff, Ohio State Highway Patrol, Brice Police, New Albany Police, Upper Arlington Police, Whitehall Police, Gahanna Police and Franklin Township Police.

The other checkpoint was in Fairfield County on July 10, 2004. The law enforcement that participated were the Ohio State Highway Patrol, Fairfield County Sheriff's Office and the Lancaster Police Department. There were 3,709 vehicles passing through the checkpoint. The results of this checkpoint were as follows:

- 679 vehicles checked
- 30 seconds was the average time per vehicle
- 150 vehicles were diverted
- 6 DUS arrests made
- 5 were cited for no operators licenses
- 0 vehicles were seized
- 5 misdemeanor arrests were made
- .12 was the average BAC
- 1 person refused
