 Total Citations Issued	 55




There were 655 vehicles through the checkpoint area and officers checked 252 of these vehicles. The average time that each vehicle was stopped was approximately 37 seconds. Thirty-seven of these vehicles were directed to the diversion area for various reasons, including not having a driver license with them, not wearing a safety belt, and suspicion of driving under the influence of alcohol.
