CHILD IDENTIFICATION STICKERS FOR CHILD SAFETY SEATS

The Ohio Emergency Medical Services for Children (EMSC) Program is making child identification stickers available to Ohio EMS agencies. The stickers are fluorescent green and contain space for identification information about the child. They are to be placed on the back or bottom of a child restraint to identify children after a severe crash if the parent/caretaker is not present, unconscious or unable to provide identifying information. The stickers also contain space for emergency contact information and any special medical needs that the child has.

These CHAD (Children Have An iDentity) stickers were developed as a result of a traffic crash involving a 13-month old boy named Chad. The babysitter who had been driving was killed. Chad was injured but no one at the scene knew his identity. The stickers have been distributed to Ohio SAFE KIDS coalitions to be used at child safety seat events throughout Ohio. However, the program is only effective if emergency providers know that the stickers are there. We appreciate any efforts to help us promote the program in your community. The stickers are available at no cost from the Ohio Division of EMS.
