MEDINA CITY DUI CHECKPOINT

The Medina City Police / Medina County Safe Communities Law Enforcement Coalition held a DUI checkpoint on September 26, 2003, from 7 p.m. to 11 p.m. There were three lanes of cars being checked at the same time by Medina City police officers. They had over 900 cars pass through the checkpoint.

Here are the totals from the Medina City Police DUI Checkpoint:

- Every 10th car was stopped at the checkpoint
- Drivers were held not more that 2.5 minutes
- NO traffic flow was impeded for North Court Street North Bound at the location of the checkpoint
- 1 arrest for driving under suspension
- 1 citation for window tint violation
- 1 citation for not wearing a seat belt (passenger front seat)
- 1 detention for a possible felony warrant
- 99 percent of all drivers and front seat passengers were wearing seat belts
- A total of 254 cars were checked at the checkpoint
- Two drivers admitted to consuming alcoholic beverages; one was given a field screen test on the portable MCI intoxilyzer
- No drivers were arrested for DUI



"I am pleased that we did not make an arrest for DUI. It means drivers are taking the measures to heart that they should not drink and drive, especially in the City of Medina where 122 drivers have been arrested this year for driving under the influence of alcohol," said Jerry Klue, director, Medina County Safe Communities and Medina City Police Department.
