

## Every 15 Minutes...

Every 15 minutes someone dies as the result of an alcohol-related crash. A national program, "Every 15 Minutes," has been designed to educate students on the dangers of drinking and driving. The two-day event reinforces what students hear about the choices they make and how that affects their life and the lives of those around them. The program offers real-life experience without the real-life risks. The Highway Patrol was asked to participate in the Springfield mock crash and aftermath.



The car crash behind Springfield South High School on the morning of December 16 wasn't real, but the tears which welled up in the eyes of some students were as wet as the drenching rain that pelted the spectators.

They watched a fellow classmate rushed to a hospital helicopter and two more loaded into a black hearse. Law enforcement and EMS officials hoped the students got the message not to drink and drive.

The program, presented by the Clark County Safe Communities Coalition, was staged at the request of the principal with the help of more than 30 community agencies. Tom Spurgin, South High School dean of students, said school officials wanted to send students a message before their winter vacation.


"Part of being an adult is making right decisions, good decisions," Lt. Joseph Gebhart of the Patrol's Springfield Post said. Lt. Gebhart guided the audience through the devastating effects of losing a loved one due to impaired driving. As each worker responded to the scene, he explained the worker's role in the crash.

"Drinking and driving can be a fatal decision," he reminded students. Gebhart said someone in the nation is killed in an alcohol-related car crash every 15 minutes. Failure to use seat belts often is a factor in those fatalities, he said.

The grim reaper pulled a student out of class every 15 minutes for the rest of the day. The reaper was accompanied by a law enforcement officer who announced that the victim had died through the actions of a drunk driver. This made a total of 26 students. The officer then read an obituary of the "deceased." Lt. Gebhart, visibly shaken, remarked that making the announcement at school was just as disturbing as making a real announcement.



The "deceased" students wore black T-shirts, painted their faces as though they were dead and even helped write their own obituaries. "Dead" students remained silent the rest of the day.



After school, the "departed" went to Wittenberg University for an overnight retreat. They wrote letters to their parents telling them things they wish they had said during their lifetime. After the letter writing and group session discussing the program's impact on them, the students participated in activities such as wearing the Fatal Vision® goggles to allow them to experience firsthand the potentially fatal consequences of alcohol and drug impairment.

The next day the rest of the student body attended the "funeral" of their departed classmates and witnessed the sentencing of the drunk driver.

"What we like to show over the next two days are the consequences," Gebhart said.

Coordinated community efforts like this one not only make the community more closely knit, they also develop a respect for all public servants who help keep the community safe.
