Staffing compliance.

- (A) Staffing compliance for a MTO licensed as basic life support, intermediate life support, or advanced life support service shall be as follows:
- (1) A licensed MTO that responds to a call for medical assistance or patient transport shall ensure that in responding to the call, a minimum of one permitted ambulance and at least two certified ~~EMTs~~emergency medical technicians, advanced emergency medical technicians, or paramedics, or combination thereof, are dispatched and respond to the call.
 - (2) A licensed MTO that responds to a call for medical assistance or patient transport shall ensure that any patient transport is done by a permitted ambulance staffed with at least two certified ~~EMTs~~emergency medical technicians, advanced emergency medical technicians, or paramedics, or combination thereof, on board.
 - (3) When an ambulance is so staffed as contained herein, the ambulance may be operated by a person who is not certified as an emergency medical technician-~~basic~~, advanced emergency medical technician-~~intermediate~~, ~~emergency medical technician-or~~ paramedic, but said operator shall receive certification in an emergency vehicle operator course that meets requirements of the national highway traffic safety administration's "1995 Emergency Vehicle Operators Course (Ambulance): National Standard Curriculum" prior to operating an ambulance.
- (B) Any non-EMS certified personnel who ~~will be driving~~ drive the ambulance or non-transport vehicle shall have completed an emergency vehicle operator course that meets ~~current~~ requirements of the national highway traffic safety administration's "1995 Emergency Vehicle Operators Course (Ambulance): National Standard Curriculum."
