Last sentence needs clarification, is misleading. J. Rose made a recommendation this sentence needs reviewed further.</p> <p>Page 2 1st paragraph, last sentence – remove the word “provided”, remove the words “for certain transports” after the word “be” add “ performed well in advance, documented and approved by the agency’s Medical Director”. 4th paragraph – replace the word “should” with “shall”, replace “certain” with “advanced”</p> <p>Additional Training: suggested edits J. Rose – Check with Dr. Cunningham on what constitutes “additional training”? Ventilator management capable of adjustments beyond just rate & volume IV Infusion pump per fusing medications requiring titration. Central line monitoring Thrombolytic therapy initiation and monitoring</p>
